1. Meeting called to order at 4:50PM.
2. Approval of Minutes of October 2nd meeting- minutes approved with corrections.
3. Middle School Accreditation
 - Ms. Neff and Mr. Weaver attended Middle Schools accreditation meeting.
 - Process should begin 16-18 months before the team visit and by six months following we should receive the report. As of now, we are behind. By next September, we are supposed to be re-accredited. We will ask for an extension aiming for spring 2014.
 - Need to identify a planning team who consists of students, staff, parents, possibly community mentors, and theoretically someone from the district. Ms. Dopkins and Mr. Weaver are leading

the Committee. This is a substantial commitment lasting for 18 months. We need representatives from the staff (each department), and parents from School Council. We do not need the entire school council.

- The Liaison from Middle States will meet with us to establish a self-study protocol. Looking at either "Excellence by Design" OR "Education for Growth".
